The BAPS-CASS Parent Advisory Group met for the second time on 12th February in Birmingham.

Once again this was a very informative meeting for both the parents attending and the research team. The parents were updated on preliminary findings for the Hirschsprung's Disease study and updated on the progress of both the Exomphalos and Gastroschisis studies. It was also extremely useful for parents to have direct input into future research, giving the research team a valuable insight into what care outcomes are most important to parents and their children. The day also provided

parents with the opportunity to meet with other families and children with similar experiences and discuss their own

experiences of having a child with an abdominal wall defect. Feedback from the day was extremely positive with parents interested to hear about the work that has been done by BAPS-

CASS and what research is planned for the future.
